**Perkins IV requirements mandate funding based on program completions for PSAV programs.**



- Digital Design broken into two 600 hour programs.
- Court Reporting broken into three programs: 840 hours, 600 hours, and 1410 hours.
- Voice Writing broken into two programs: 750 hours, and 870 hours.
- New CIP numbers will be assigned to these programs
- Secondary programs will not be affected.

### **2008-2009 Options**

- Advanced International Certificate of Education (AICE) Accounting 1 and 2 can be substitution options for Accounting Applications 1 and 2 in programs where they occur.
- AICE courses weighted at 150% (an A is 6 points)
- Successful completion of end-of-course exam guarantees college credit at Florida universities.
- Gold Seal eligible credit.

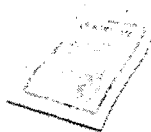

**CATER Reading Program  
Pilot**

- CTE teachers will teach Intensive Reading Courses using their content.
- Citrus, Polk, and Volusia representative teachers receive concentrated training - summer 2008.
- Reading intervention to be provided for fluent Level 1 and 2 students in a 1-period CTE reading integrated course and for disfluent students through a 1 period CTE course blocked with 1 period of intensive reading.

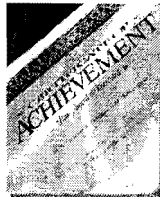
